- Inclusion does not guarantee funding or completion

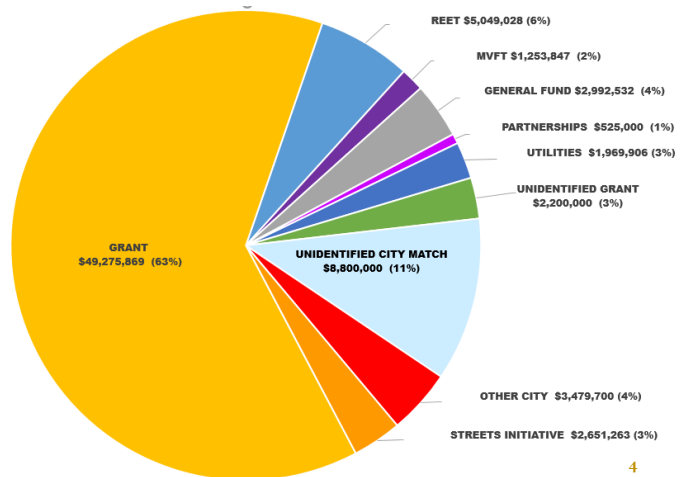

 - 16 Completed

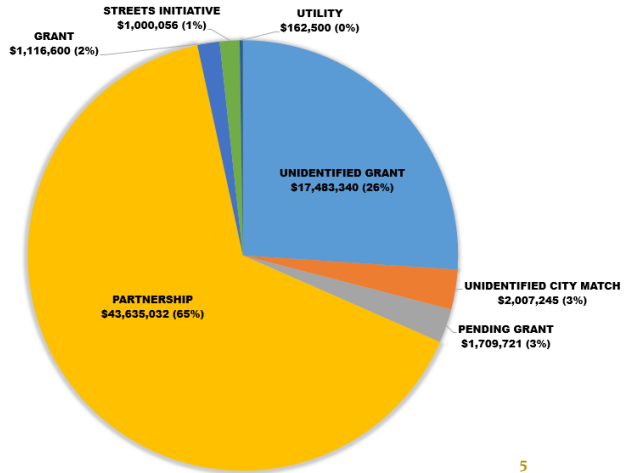

 - 1 Major Project

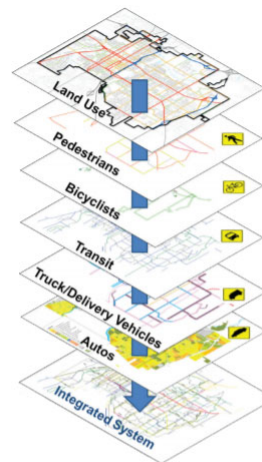
