*Increase the number of Seattle residents who can donate to and support local campaigns.* 




# Who can use vouchers?


# **Residents:**

- Seattle residents receive four \$25 vouchers they can use to donate to candidates running for City of Seattle offices. Residents must be:
  - Over 18
  - Seattle Resident
  - Citizen, Legal Permanent Resident, or U.S. National

# **Candidates:**

• Candidates may use voucher proceeds to help fund their campaigns.

# Outcomes 10 of 11 currently elected officials participated in the program. Seattle donors now more closely resemble Seattle voters and come from all over the city. Steady decline in out-of-city donations. Example: 2017 Mayoral (No DVP) = 23% from outside the city. 2021 Mayoral (with DVP) = 7% from outside the city. Increased number of contributors. Example: 2017 Mayoral (No DVP) = 10k contributors. 2021 Mayoral (with DVP) = 38k contributors.
