



RESOLUTION NO. 41317

1 A RESOLUTION authorizing the execution of an agreement with Harold LeMay
2 Enterprises, Incorporated, d.b.a. Pierce County Refuse, in the amount of
3 \$325,000, budgeted from the Solid Waste Fund, to purchase the franchise
4 rights for solid waste collection in the Manitou Annexation Area, effective
5 April 1, 2024.

6 WHEREAS an Interlocal Agreement (“ILA”) and the Memorandum of
7 Understanding (“MOU”) governing the annexation of the Manitou area and
8 establishing the transition of governmental services from the County to the City
9 were signed and officially executed on December 15, 2021, and

10 WHEREAS through the ILA and MOU, the County and the City are
11 committed to completing the annexation and ensuring an effective transition of
12 appropriate governmental services, and

13 WHEREAS this agreement allows solid waste collection services to be
14 transitioned to the City of Tacoma effective April 1, 2024, and

15 WHEREAS Environmental Services recommends authorizing execution of
16 the agreement to purchase the franchise rights for solid waste collections in the
17 Manitou Annexation area to allow customers within the annexation area to have
18 access to City of Tacoma Solid Waste collection services; Now, Therefore,

19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

20 Section 1. That the Council of the City of Tacoma concurs with the
21 recommendation for execution of an agreement with Harold LeMay Enterprises,
22 Incorporated, dba Pierce County Refuse.
