SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

The purpose of this item is to Request an Ordinance for a 10-year Telecommunications Franchise Agreement between the City of Tacoma and SQF, LLC (Verta). We have reviewed their request, negotiated terms, and reached a tentative agreement pending City Council consideration and approval. Based on SQF, LLC's (Verta) Financial and Technical abilities, and History as a provider.

BACKGROUND:

This department's recommendation is based on State and Local Law which requires a Telecommunications Provider to have a Franchise Agreement to operate in the City of Tacoma Public Right of Way.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:

Businesses in our community will be impacted by this decision as SQF, LLC (Verta) will offer competitive services at competitive rates.
