**SUMMARY:**

Reappointing the following individuals to the Landmarks Preservation Commission:

- Reappointing Jennifer Sullivan to the “At-Large 2” position to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2025, to expire December 31, 2027.
- Reappointing George Zeno to the “At-Large 3” position to serve a three-year term, effective January 1, 2025, to expire December 31, 2027.

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

As the Landmarks Preservation Commission (Commission) oversees the establishment and regulation of landmarks, local historic districts, proposed name changes for public facilities, and certain property tax incentives, appointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic policy priority to foster neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability.
