

RESOLUTION NO. 41741

A RESOLUTION relating to stormwater management; authorizing the execution of a second amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the Port of Tacoma, for mutual cooperation and support regarding agency stormwater management, to extend the agreement through December 31, 2025.

WHEREAS an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") between the City and the Port of Tacoma ("Port") has been in place since 2020, and was adopted by Resolution No. 40655, and

WHEREAS in February 2025, the City Council adopted Resolution

No. 41617, authorizing a first Amendment to the ILA to extend the ILA for six

months to allow for negotiations between the Port and the City, with a new

expiration date of August 31, 2025, and the Port and the City began negotiations

to create a mutually beneficial ILA that works best for both parties, and

WHEREAS during this extension, the City released their draft

Stormwater Management Manual for public comment, and the Port reviewed and submitted comments on this document in May 2025, and

WHEREAS the reissuance of both the Department of Ecology Phase I Stormwater and Industrial Stormwater General Permits during 2024 led to delays in negotiations, and

WHEREAS this second amendment will keep the current terms, but extend the expiration date by four months, from August 31, 2025, to December 31, 2025, and allows time to finalize negotiations on matters covered by the ILA; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute a second amendment to the Interlocal Agreement with the Port of Tacoma, for mutual cooperation and support regarding agency stormwater management, to extend the agreement from August 31, 2025, through December 31, 2025, as more specifically set forth in the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
