Call To Order

Chair Walker called the special meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

HUD Annual Action Plan and Consolidated Plan Recommendations [Carey Jenkins, Community and Economic Development]

At approximately 4:30 p.m., Carey Jenkins, Community and Economic Development, stated staff is seeking approval from the Committee for the 2015-2016 Annual Action Plan, 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan, amended Citizen Participation Plan, and new sub-recipient agreements between the City and the Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority. He then reviewed the 2015-2019 Consolidated Plan purpose, approach, community outreach, and strategic plan goals. Mr. Jenkins next reviewed the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) community planning and development allocation, 2015-2016 Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) funds, and proposed recommendations for CDBG reprogramming, housing funding, Tacoma Community Redevelopment Authority housing activities, and economic development funding. He also reviewed the Valhalla Hall adaptive reuse project, allocation of the 2015-2016 HOME Investment Partnerships Program funds, and next steps. Discussion ensued regarding the proposed CDBG reprogramming, including local improvement district (LID) assistance funds, and the economic development fund.

Discussion ensued regarding CDBG funding allocation for human services, and proposed CDBG funding, including the LID Assistance Program, whether sidewalk improvements can be funded by the LID Assistance Program, and single family residence blight abatement. Discussion continued regarding the Valhalla Hall project background, and recommended economic development funding, including contingencies for the William Factory Small Business Incubator, and the Spaceworks program description and scope of work. Chair Walker requested background information and the current status of the \$100,000 LID funding set aside for the Hilltop neighborhood, and the William Factory Small Business Incubator clinic.

MOTION: Deputy Mayor Boe moved to approve the recommendations and authorize staff to present the recommendations to the City Council at study session on March 31, 2015.

ACTION: Voice vote was taken and carried. The motion was declared adopted.
