2	TA RESOLUTION IN Support of the Broadway Center for the Performing Alls
3	("Broadway Center") Theater District Centennial Campaign, and pledging up to \$10 million in funding by 2020 for capital improvement projects,
4	subject to future appropriation authority and funding availability and contingent upon funds generated by the Broadway Center.
5	WHEREAS the City owns the Pantages Theater, Rialto Theater, and
6	
7 8	Theatre on the Square, which together form the nucleus of the City's Theater
о 9	District, and
9 10	WHEREAS the Broadway Center for the Performing Arts ("Broadway
11	Center") has managed and operated these venues for over 30 years on the City's
12	behalf, and
13	WHEREAS, as the Theater District approaches its 100th anniversary, the
14	aging structures require significant investment to ensure safety, restoration, and
15	elevated function, and
16	WHEREAS the Broadway Center is committed to the stewardship of these
17	
18	assets and has determined that funding in the amount of \$35.3 million is required
19	to maintain these assets and complete essential capital improvements and
20	required ADA renovations, and
21	WHEREAS, in October 2014, the Executive Director of Broadway Center
22 23	and Chair of the Capital Campaign presented campaign details to the Economic
23 24	Development Committee of the City Council, and
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	WHEREAS the Broadway Center is committed to raising \$15.3 million
1	through a Centennial Capital Campaign, with an additional \$10 million anticipated
2	to be generated through tax credits, for said purposes, and
3 4	WHEREAS, as the owner of the buildings, the City's support is critical to
5	the success of the Broadway Center's Centennial Capital Campaign, and
6	WHEREAS the City has been asked to commit up to \$10 million in funding
7	by 2020 to supplement funding generated by the Broadway Center towards the
8	required renovation costs, and
9 10	WHEREAS, over the 2015-2016 biennium, the City will provide \$1 million
11	to the Broadway Center in contractually obligated funding for theater
12	maintenance, as well as \$1.5 million for the Capital Campaign, for a total of
13	\$2.5 million, and
14	WHEREAS, in order to reach the goal of \$10 million in City funding by
15 16	2020, City staff anticipates providing an additional \$2 million for contractual
17	maintenance, consisting of \$1 million in the 2017-2018 biennium and \$1 million in
18	the 2019-2020 biennium; as well as \$5.5 Million for Capital Campaign
19	contributions, consisting of \$3 million in the 2017-2018 biennium and \$2.5 million
20	in the 2019-2020 biennium, with all funding contingent upon future funding
21 22	availability and appropriation authority; Now, Therefore,
23	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA
24	That the City Council hereby expresses its support for the Broadway
25	Center for the Performing Art's ("Broadway Center") Centennial Campaign, and
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1	pledges funding in an amount up to \$10 million by 2020 for capital improvement
2	projects, subject to future appropriation authority and funding availability and
3	contingent upon funds generated by the Broadway Center.
