



RESOLUTION NO. 41050

1 A RESOLUTION related to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a two-
 2 year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the Tacoma
 3 Joint Labor Committee, effective January 1, 2023, through December 31,
 2024.

4 WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective
 5 bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and
 6 the administration, and

7 WHEREAS this resolution allows for the execution of a two-year Collective
 8 Bargaining Agreement (“CBA”) between the City and the Tacoma Joint Labor
 9 Committee (“Union”), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

10 WHEREAS the Union is comprised of the following employee Unions:
 11 Professional & Technical Employees (PROTEC17), Local 17; Tacoma Firefighters
 12 Union, Local 31; Teamsters Local Union No. 117; Washington State Council of
 13 County and City Employees, Local 120; International Association of Machinists &
 14 Aerospace Workers, District 160; Teamsters Local 313; and International
 15 Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, and

16 WHEREAS the CBA provides for the continuation of employee health and
 17 welfare benefits for the term of the two-year agreement, and

18 WHEREAS the CBA was considered and approved by the Public Utility
 19 Board at its meeting of October 12, 2022, and

20 WHEREAS it appears in the best interests of the City that the CBA
 21 negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,
