ORDER AMENDING HEARING EXAMINER'S RECOMMENDATION TO THE CITY COUNCIL

THIS MATTER, involving the vacation of a portion of Milwaukee Way, came before Hearing Examiner Phyllis K. Macleod for hearing on September 26, 2013, at the joint request of the City of Tacoma (City) and the Port of Tacoma. After the record in the matter was held open for further supplementation by the parties, a Report and Recommendation to the Tacoma City Council was issued by the Hearing Examiner on October 23, 2013. After receipt of the Report and Recommendation, the Port of Tacoma requested that the Hearing Examiner reconsider the language in one condition of the street vacation. The original Report and Recommendation indicated that an easement would be retained by the City over the vacated area for existing sanitary and storm sewer systems. The Port of Tacoma is assuming ownership of the existing storm sewer main as part of the street vacation and, therefore, the City will not need an easement for the storm sewer system. Accordingly, the Port of Tacoma is seeking a modification of the language governing the easement requirement. The City agrees with the suggested modification.
