DATE: June 7, 2023

I ask for your support for a Council Contingency Fund expenditure of \$6,000 to sponsor the Buffalo Soldiers Museum's event, "Honoring Our Military Labor Force."

LEGISLATIVE INTENT

Council Contingency Fund Request: The Buffalo Soldiers Museum is non-profit dedicated to honoring the Buffalo Soldiers and serving as a haven for students and members of the community to learn about a piece of history that took place between 1866 and 1944. The museum provides significant educational, historical, and cultural resources and has a longstanding, robust relationship with the region's large active duty and veteran military population, local tribal leadership, and Tacoma's BIPOC community.

This contingency fund request would allow the City to be a sponsor for the Buffalo Soldiers Museum's "Honoring Our Military Labor Force," event on September 4, 2023, at Cheney Stadium. The event is a long-standing tradition in Tacoma that celebrates the legacy of the Buffalo Soldiers, Tacoma's BIPOC community, and current and retired military members and their families. This year's event will include a softball game and free family and youth activities.

This contingency fund request would allow the City to sponsor at the "Grand Slam" level. This sponsorship level provides the following and would help ensure family-friendly entertainment activities for the event:

- Company Name and Logo on all Festival flyers and P.R.
- Company Name and Logo displayed on the video board at Cheney Stadium during event softball game
- Company Name and Logo on Buffalo Soldiers Museum's 2024 Military and Baseball History Calendar
- 25 reserved tickets to sponsor suite for event softball game
- Wave vendor fee (if interested in also being a vendor)

FUNDING REQUESTED:

\$6,000.00

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ (CUSTOMER RESEARCH):

The Buffalo Soldiers Museum organizes this event yearly for the residents of Tacoma as a tribute to our military forces, past and present. The event will be free for all to attend, enabling a wide array of residents to participate. The Buffalo Soldiers Museum is advertising the event to the public.

2025 STRATEGIC PRIORITIES:

Equity and Accessibility:

This event helps educate and inform residents about the Buffalo Soldiers, build community support and appreciation for the region's active duty and veteran military population, and celebrate Tacoma's BIPOC community. This event is a community-building, family-friendly day of fun and appreciation for service members from all branches of the armed forces.

Education: *Equity Index Score*: Moderate Opportunity

Increase the number of quality out of school time learning opportunities distributed equitably across the city.

Civic Engagement: *Equity Index Score*: Moderate Opportunity

Increase the percentage of residents who believe they are able to have a positive impact on the community and express trust in the public institutions in Tacoma.

Livability: *Equity Index Score*: Moderate Opportunity

Improve access and proximity by residents to diverse income levels and race/ethnicity to community facilities, services, infrastructure, and employment.

Explain how your legislation will affect the selected indicator(s)?

This one-time contingency fund will sponsor the work of Buffalo Soldiers Museum in Tacoma and their efforts to share their educational, historical, and cultural resources with the Tacoma community. The event will also be free to the public, enabling broad participation in this family-friendly event celebrating diversity and service.

EVALUATIONS AND FOLLOW UP:

These contingency funds are provided to sponsor the Buffalo Soldiers Museum Festival, "Honoring Our Military Labor Force." The contingency funds are intended as a one-time funding source. Event organizers will be provided with information on how to apply for funding opportunities and request sponsorship for future conferences during standard programmatic application cycles.

SPONSOR RECOMMENDATION:

Sponsors recommend providing \$6,000.00 to sponsor the Buffalo Soldiers Museum Labor Day Festival, "Honoring Our Military Labor Force."

FISCAL IMPACT:

\$6,000.00 from Council Contingency Funds.
