SUMMARY:

The Public Works Engineering Division recommends a contract be awarded to low bidder Miles Resources LLC, Puyallup, WA, for completing a grind and overlay of Milwaukee Way from 600 feet south of Marshall Avenue to the north SR 509 frontage road. The contract amount reflects a total award of \$214,112.95, plus approximately 20 percent in contingency, for a cumulative amount of \$256,936.00, sales tax not applicable.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

• Plan for and improve public infrastructure that meets the transportation needs of all Tacoma residents and visitors.

This project improves pavement conditions on an important street in the Tideflats area that carries freight and provides residents access to businesses in that area.

BACKGROUND:

ISSUE: The Milwaukee Way Phase 2 Overlay Project improves a section of roadway within the City's Heavy Haul Corridor. The project includes grinding the existing asphalt and overlaying the existing pavement with new asphalt.

ALTERNATIVES: The alternative to grinding and overlaying the existing asphalt pavement with new asphalt pavement would be to remove the existing pavement and replace with concrete pavement. Based on the condition of the existing road surface and the cost of removal and replacement with concrete pavement, a grind and overlay provides the most economical solution.


COMPETITIVE SOLICITATION: Request for Bids Specification No. PW 15-0016F was opened February 24, 2015. Four submittals were received. The table below reflects the amount of the bids, sales tax not applicable.

SUSTAINABILITY: This grind and overlay project reduces the amount of material requiring disposal over total removal and replacement of the asphalt pavement with concrete pavement.

DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE (DBE): The recommended contract is in compliance with 49 Code of Federal Regulations Part 26, per memorandum dated March 6, 2015. The DBE goal for this project is 11 percent, and the DBE participation is 12.1 percent. The designated training hours for this project are 0 hours.
