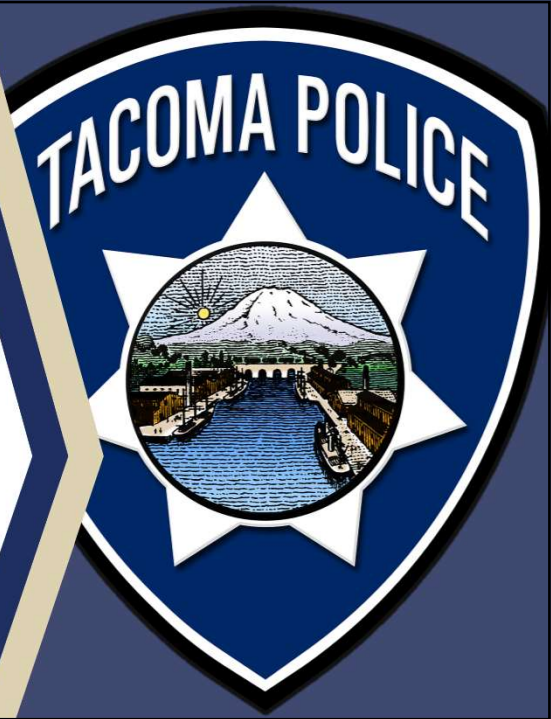

*Gunshot location detection system alerts will not be canceled. Supervisors must monitor gunshot location detection system alerts for proper officer response and officer safety. Supervisors will ensure that a minimum of two officers respond.

"After [looking at the details](#) of ShotSpotter's system, we didn't think it posed an active threat to privacy, but we were concerned about the precedent it set (and [others](#) agreed)." Jay Stanley, ACLU Speech, Privacy and Technology Senior Policy Analyst met with the CEO of shotspotter and changed his tune.
