### Background

- Chapter 1.29 of the City of Tacoma Municipal Code was passed in 1967.
- Provides protection from discrimination within the City limits.
- Civil Rights Enforcement Contracts
  - U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)
  - U.S. Equal Employment Opportunity Commission (EEOC)

### Program Improvements

- Pilot Service Delivery Model Shift
  - Contract Investigators vs. Full-time Investigator are conducting investigations
  - Temporary Administrative Staff assists the City to comply with HUD's regulatory changes
  - Partnership with the Washington State Human Rights Commission (WSHRC)

#### **Investigation Trend Summary**

- The Department continues to receive a high number of inquiries from community members, businesses and housing providers regarding potential discrimination and compliance with antidiscrimination laws
- Despite the increase in inquiries, the number of actual complaints filed has decreased statewide
- A majority of the cases filed with the NCS Department allege race and/or disability discrimination
