2014 Canceled Council Meetings

DATE:

December 4, 2013, for the December 17, 2013 Council Meeting

SUMMARY:

A resolution approving the cancellation of seven regular City Council meetings in 2014: January 2nd; March 11th; May 27th; September 2nd; November 12th; December 23rd; and December 30th.

COUNCIL SPONSORS:

BACKGROUND:

Per the City Charter, Procedure of the Council, Section 2.8, the City Council shall meet at least forty-six times each calendar year. Therefore, the City Council, by a majority vote, can cancel up to seven meetings in 2014, and still meet the regular meeting requirements.

Per the Tacoma City Council Rules of Procedure, Rule 1-Meetings, Section A-Regular Meeting, the rule states: (1) If Tuesday of any week is a legal holiday, the regular meeting of that week shall be held at 5:00 p.m. on the next business day; and, (2) If Tuesday of any week shall fall on Christmas Eve or New Year's Eve, the regular meeting of that week shall be held at 5:00 p.m. on the next business day.

At the December 3, 2013 Committee of the Whole meeting, the Council discussed the various options for the seven meetings they could consider cancelling in 2014.

ISSUE:

For agenda planning purposes, each year the City Council discusses their preference for which City Council meetings to cancel in the next calendar year. Because December 31st, New Year's Eve, falls on a Tuesday and New Year's Day falls on the following day, January 1st, the first Council meeting in January 2014 would fall on Thursday, January 2nd, per the City Council Rules of Procedure. In addition, per the same Council rule, Veterans Day, November 11th falls on a Tuesday, which means the Council meeting would occur the next business day, Wednesday, November 12th.

RECOMMENDATION:

Since legal holidays change the dates of the Council meetings on January 1st and November 11th, the Council wanted to be consistent in holding their meetings on Tuesdays, rather than the next business day per the Council's Rules of Procedure. At the December 3rd Committee of the Whole meeting, Council expressed an interest in canceling the January 2nd (Thursday) and November 12th (Wednesday) Council meetings. In addition, the Council expressed an interest in cancelling the March 11th, May 27th, September 2nd, December 23rd, and December 30th, for a total of seven canceled meetings.
