1. <u>22-0550</u> Human Services Commission Interviews [Doris Sorum, City Clerk]

At approximately 4:34 p.m., Doris Sorum, City Clerk, informed the Committee they would be interviewing seven applicants for the Human Services Commission; two applicants invited to interview withdrew; and that seven positions are available, including six member positions and one youth position, but there are only six positions to consider, as no applicants qualified for the youth position
