SUMMARY:

Appointing, reappointing, and reassigning the following individuals to the City Events and Recognitions Committee:

- Appointing Prachi Goyal to the “At-Large No. 1” position to serve a three-year term, effective July 1, 2026, to expire June 30, 2029.
- Appointing Kennysha Johnson to the “At-Large No. 4” position to fill an unexpired term, to expire June 30, 2027, followed by a three-year term, to expire June 30, 2030.
- Appointing Jerry Rice to the “At-Large No. 6” position to serve a three-year term, effective July 1, 2026, to expire June 30, 2029.
- Reappointing and reassigning Keoni Ho from the “At-Large No. 1” position to the “Council District No. 2” position effective July 1, 2026, to expire June 30, 2027, followed by a three-year term to expire June 30, 2030.
