

Proposed Alternative Process For Filling Council Member Vacancy

Suspend the portions of Rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure Related to the process of Filling a Council Vacancy (must be voted on and approved by five council members) as follows:

Proposed new process

1. Each council member (and the Mayor) will select eight (8) applicants from the list (applicants who live outside the city limits or filed after the deadline will be excluded)
2. The council member's selections will be made public. (see sample form)
3. The City Clerk's Office will compile the selections and create a list of applicants that will make a presentation to Council.
4. All applicants selected will be given three (3) minutes to make a presentation to the Council.
5. Following the presentations the Council may go into executive session to discuss the qualifications of the applicants.
6. Each Council member will select four (4) applicants to become finalists. The Council member's selections will be made public. If there is a tie resulting in more than four finalists, the Council will debate in an open public meeting whether to increase the number of finalists or exclude the ties.
7. All finalists selected will be provided a 15 minute interview with the Council as follows: One (1) minute introduction by the applicant, 13 minutes of question/answer from the Council, and one (1) minute to provide closing remarks.
8. The Council may go into executive session to discuss the qualifications of the finalists.
9. The finalists shall be placed in alphabetical order according to last names. The City Clerk shall proceed with a roll-call vote of each finalist until a nominee receives a majority (5 votes) of the Council.

Proposed Timeline

July 12, 2022 – Study session discuss alternative process and executive session to discuss qualifications of the applicants

July 12, 2022 – Evening meeting Council members select their top eight applicants

July 19, 2022 – Evening meeting Council hears the three minute presentations from selected applicants

July 26, 2022 – Study session executive session to discuss qualifications of the applicants

July 26, 2022 – Evening meeting Council members select their four finalists

August 2, 2022 – Evening meeting Council interviews finalists

August 9, 2022 – Study session executive session to discuss qualifications of the finalists

August 9, 2022 – Evening meeting Council members vote on new council member

August 16, 2022 – Swear in the new Council Member

August 2, 2022	Evening meeting Council interviews finalists <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All finalists selected will be provided a 15 minute interview with the Council as follows: One (1) minute introduction by the applicant, 13 minutes of question/answer from the Council, and one (1) minute to provide closing remarks. • The Council may go into executive session to discuss the qualifications of the finalists.
August 9, 2022	Study session executive session to discuss qualifications of the finalists

The City Clerk shall proceed with a roll-call vote of each finalist until a nominee receives a majority (5 votes) of the Council.
