OVERVIEW



- Request for an Ordinance for a 10-year Telecommunications Franchise Agreement
- This is the second 10-year Franchise Agreement with Port of Tacoma (previous 2011 Ord.# 28016) which was a Limited Area Franchise Agreement
- Legal, Financial, Technical aspects as a provider in our community were reviewed
- Negotiated terms and updated with code changes that have occurred over the last 13 years

•••OVERVIEW



- Port of Tacoma has had infrastructure in the City Right of Way for just over 13 years
- Due to the Auburn Case (2001) state law does not allow Franchise Fees to be paid as part of this agreement

*******BACKGROUND



- Allows the Port of Tacoma to continue to operate within the City Right of Way for another 10 years
- Protects and Indemnifies the city
- Requires the necessary bonds, letter of credit and insurance required by Title 10 and Title 16B of the Tacoma Municipal Code

SECTION



- The Ordinance Request keeps Port of Tacoma operating within Federal, State, and Local Law operating within Municipal Code - Title 10 and Title 16B
- This proposed ordinance maintains/improves community conditions: Livability; Economy and Workforce; Equity and Accessibility; Sustainability
