SUMMARY:

Appointing Kashmiri Gavronski to the Board of Ethics to fill an unexpired term, to expire December 31, 2024, followed by a three-year term to expire December 31, 2027.

COUNCIL SPONSORS:

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

Appointing an individual to the Board best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to encouraging and promoting an open, effective, results-oriented organization because the Board receives, investigates, and makes recommendations for disposition of complaints of violation of the Code of Ethics by current or former City-elected officials; the City Manager; the Director of Public Utilities; or a member of the Public Utility Board.

BACKGROUND:

At the June 6, 2023, Government Performance and Finance Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews, and at the June 20, 2023, meeting, the Committee conducted an additional interview and recommended the appointment of the individual listed above.

ISSUE:

A position needs to be filled on the Board of Ethics.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board will continue to operate without full membership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Government Performance and Finance Committee is recommending the appointment of the individual listed above.
