- Appointing Erin Anderson to the “Architecture, Historic Preservation, Urban Design” position to fill an unexpired term, to expire June 30, 2028.
- Appointing Lyle Crews to the “Development Community” position to serve a three-year term, effective July 1, 2026, to expire June 30, 2029.
- Reappointing and reassigning Anthony Steele from the “Development Community” position to the “District No. 1” position to serve a three-year term, effective July 1, 2026, to expire June 30, 2029.
- Reappointing Christopher Karnes to the “Public Transportation” position to serve a three-year term, effective July 1, 2026, to expire June 30, 2029.
