1 A RESOLUTION related to the purchase of materials, supplies or equipment,
2 and the furnishing of services; authorizing the waiver of competitive
3 procurement procedures due to sole source availability; and authorizing
4 the execution of a contract with South Sound Outreach Services d.b.a.
5 Sound Outreach, in the amount of \$226,005, plus applicable taxes,
6 budgeted from the Tacoma Training and Employment Program Fund, for
7 case management, employment coaching, financial empowerment, and
8 supportive services to Tacoma residents and residents of Tacoma Public
9 Utilities' service areas identified to participate in the pre-apprenticeship
10 program, for an initial contract period of one year, with the option to
11 renew for three additional one-year periods, for a projected contract total
12 of \$925,000, pursuant to Direct Negotiation.

9 WHEREAS the City has complied with all applicable laws and processes
10 governing the acquisition of those supplies, and/or the procurement of those
11 services, inclusive of public works, as is shown by the attached Exhibit "A,"
12 incorporated herein as though fully set forth, and

13 WHEREAS the Board of Contracts and Awards has concurred with the
14 recommendation for award as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A"; Now,

17 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

18 Section 1. That the Council of the City of Tacoma concurs with the
19 Board of Contracts and Awards to adopt the recommendation for award as set
20 forth in the attached Exhibit "A," and authorizes the waiver of competitive
21 procurement procedures due to sole source availability.

23 Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to
24 enter into a contract with South Sound Outreach Services d.b.a. Sound Outreach,
25 in the amount of \$226,005, plus applicable taxes, budgeted from the Tacoma
