

## **RESOLUTION NO. 39417**

A RESOLUTION related to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Custodial and Building Maintenance Unit, effective retroactive to January 1, 2016, until December 31, 2019.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS this resolution allows for the execution of a proposed four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City and the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Custodial and Building Maintenance Unit ("Union"), on behalf of employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the bargaining unit consists of approximately 26 budgeted, full-time equivalent ("FTE") positions, with 21 FTEs located within Tacoma Public Utilities ("TPU") and five FTEs located within General Government, and

WHEREAS the proposed CBA will provide for a wage increase of 2 percent retroactive to January 1, 2016; a wage increase of 2 percent effective January 1, 2017; a wage increase of 2 percent effective January 1, 2018; and a wage increase of 2 percent effective January 1, 2019, and

WHEREAS other changes to the CBA include: (1) changing language in articles relating to Discipline, Non-Discrimination, Grievance Procedure, Temporary Vacancies, Selection of Personnel and Hours of Work; (2) incorporating a previous Letter of Understanding regarding the process for determining set ups at TPU; (3) providing language regarding a bid process for TPU Custodians for scheduled



overtime, and how overtime opportunities are to be assigned; and (4) moving language relating to time off and benefits to Appendix B, and

WHEREAS the CBA was considered and approved by the Public Utility Board at its meeting of March 23, 2016, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interests of the City that the proposed CBA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the four-year Collective Bargaining Agreement between the City and International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 483, Custodial and Building Maintenance Unit, effective retroactive to January 1, 2016, through December 31, 2019, said document to be substantially in the form of the proposed agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk.
