Sustainable Materials Management Plan Update [James Parvey, Assistant Division Manager, Office of Environmental Policy and Sustainability, Environmental Services; Katie Kennedy, Cascadia Consulting; and Phil Coughlan, Herrera, Inc.]

At approximately 4:38 p.m., James Parvey, Environmental Services,

Katie Kennedy, Cascadia Consulting, and Phil Coughlan, Herrera, Inc., provided an overview of the Sustainable Materials Management Plan. They discussed key findings, including stakeholder interviews, material recovery facility (MRF), study and survey, waste generation, recoverables, and 2028 projections; and scenarios, including common elements, and alternative scenarios.

Discussion ensued throughout regarding MRF, current and future needs, JMK waste management fibers, equity and incentives, analyzing scenarios, next steps, Sustainable Commission, surveys and pre-cycling.
