

RESOLUTION NO. 39014

BY REQUEST OF MAYOR STRICKLAND

A RESOLUTION relating to community and economic development; establishing a Commission on International Relations to foster positive international relations for education, the arts, tourism, and economic development.

WHEREAS, in 2014, Mayor Strickland joined with Mayor Murray of Seattle and Mayor Stephanson of Everett to launch a pilot project called the Global Cities Initiative, sponsored by the Brookings Institution and JP Morgan Chase, and

WHEREAS this project will examine the market for foreign direct investment in the Seattle metropolitan area, of which Tacoma is a component, and develop a plan for strategic pursuit of foreign direct investment, and

WHEREAS many organizations and businesses in Tacoma have a stake in fostering positive international relations for education, the arts, tourism, and economic development, and

WHEREAS it would be in the best interest of the City to establish a

Commission comprised of representatives of these organizations to develop a

unified agenda and strategy for Tacoma, said representatives to be appointed by
the Mayor; Now Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

Section 1. That the Mayor is directed to establish a Commission on International Relations to foster positive international relations for education, the arts, tourism, and economic development.
