SUMMARY:

The Tacoma Pierce County Chamber of Commerce will participate, and assist in facilitating a discussion with a panel of business and industry representatives related to community involvement and a 2023 Business Survey as directed in Substitute Ordinance 28838 and Resolution 41069.

BACKGROUND:

Resolution 41069 directs the EDC to review how the City can improve communications, better support local businesses, conduct community outreach as well as how it could use existing revenues to support community services that also meet the particular needs of the business community, and ensuring the City is prioritizing anti-racism in the evaluation of new policies and programs.
