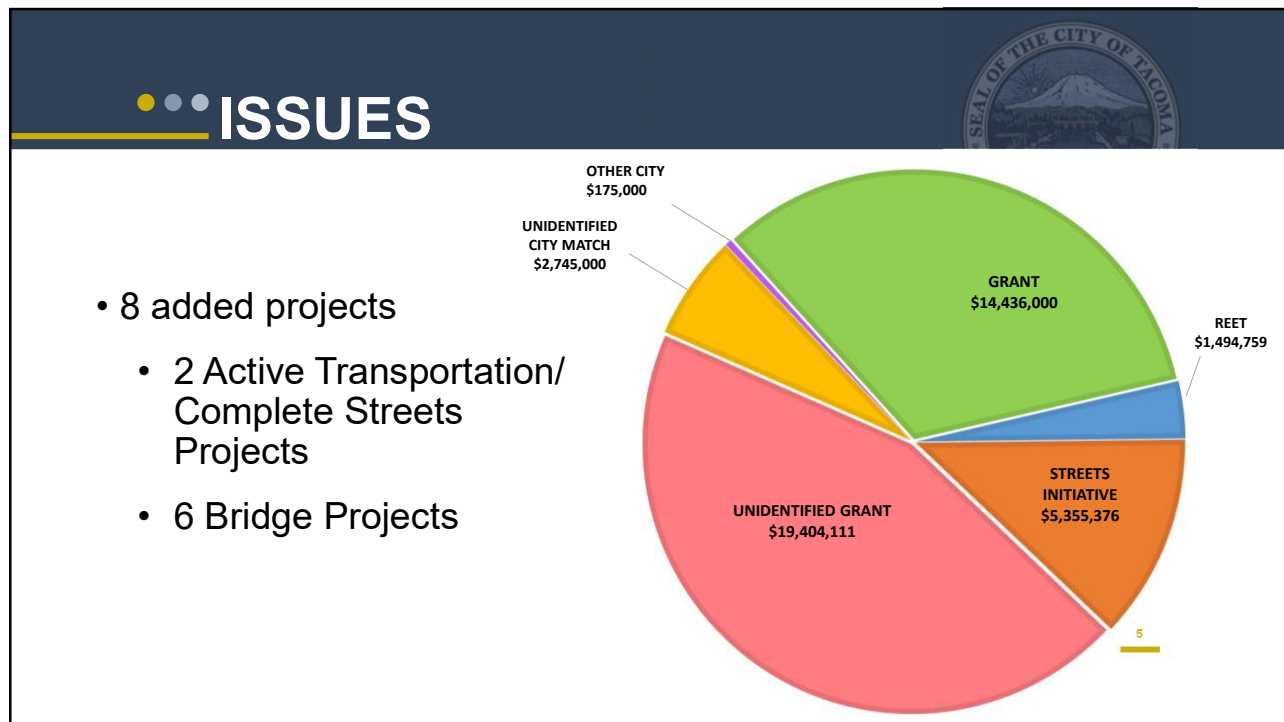

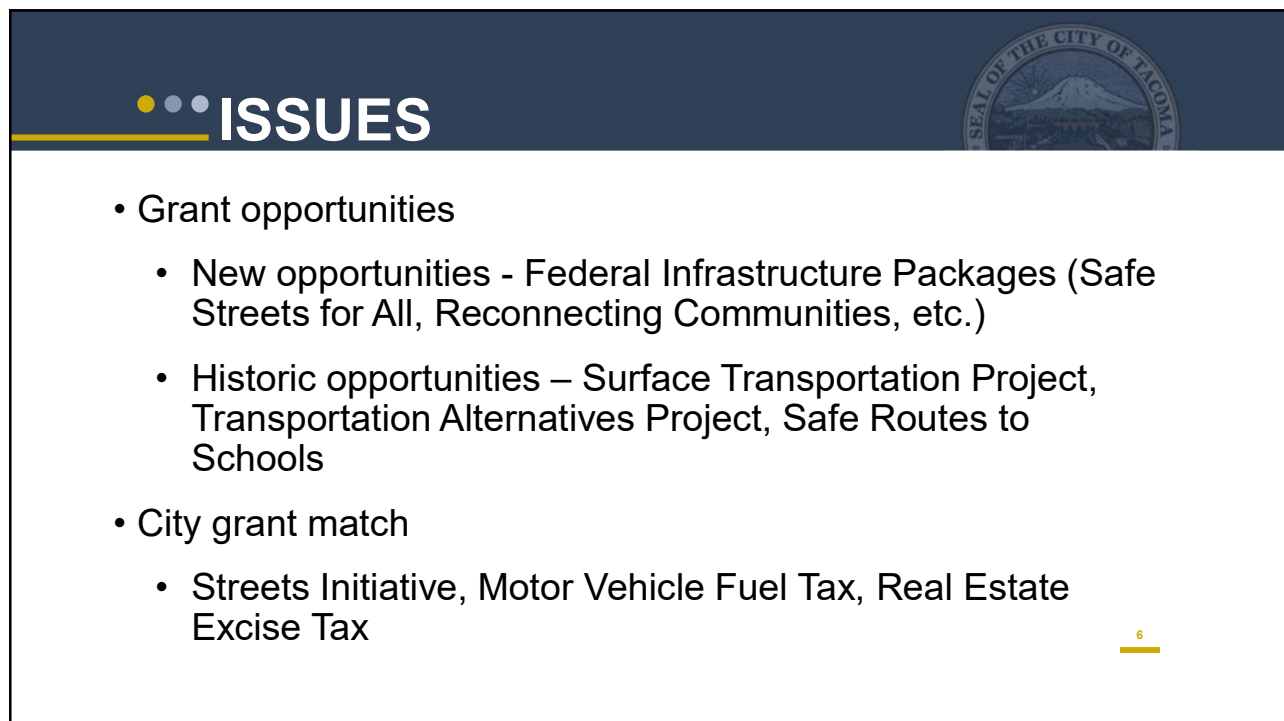

Project Detail: This project will add bicycle lanes to connect from the Scott Pierson Trail to the Prairie Line Trail, and upgrade curb ramps.

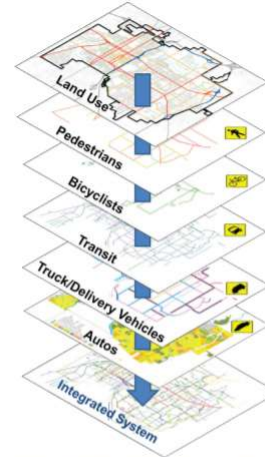
