SUMMARY: Tacoma Rail requests authorization to enter into a Loan Agreement with the Washington State Department of Transportation for the purpose of upgrading two heavily used tracks connected to the North and South Intermodal Yards.

BACKGROUND: Subsequent to applying for financial assistance to upgrade existing railroad track infrastructure, WSDOT notified Tacoma Rail that \$1,622,000 was awarded. Loan Agreement RRB-1297 requires Tacoma Rail to contribute \$1,118,625 in matching funds toward completion of the project, is for a ten-year term, requires annual payments of \$162,200 beginning on December 1, 2025, and includes a \$32,000 administrative fee.
