SUMMARY:

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Citizen Police Advisory Committee:

Appointing Christian Issac to the At-Large No. 4 position to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2018; and reappointing Ryan Webster to the Council District 1 position to serve a three-year term to expire December 31, 2019.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

Appointing individuals to the Committee best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to encouraging and promoting an open, effective, results-oriented organization as the Committee is a policy-focused board that will help to ensure transparency and accountability in the way that the Tacoma Police Department operates.

BACKGROUND:
