1. <u>15-1376</u> Veterans Internship Program (VIP)

At approximately 12:03 p.m., Mark Lauzier, Assistant City Manager, provided a brief overview of the Veterans Internship Program, and introduced Joy St. Germain and Teresa Dent, Human Resources, and Anita Gallagher, City Manager's Office. Ms. St. Germain provided background information on the program.

Ms. Gallagher and Ms. Dent continued the presentation with issues, program information, and direct recruitment initiatives. Ms. St. Germain discussed next steps and introduced the interns participating in the program, Tymmber Arnold, Jonah Wallace, Jamie Scott, and Marvin Cooks.

2. <u>15-1377</u> Lincoln District Revitalization Program Update

Mr. Noguera provided an update on the program, including the recent open house, area boundaries, project investment, goals, and introduced Carol Wolfe, and Debbie Bingham,

Ms. Wolfe discussed major milestones met, and Ms. Bingham discussed areas of focus, including infrastructure, housing and property conditions, code compliance programs, human and social services, public safety, economic development, urban design and community vitality, arts and cultural vitality and next steps.
