RECOMMENDATION: The Public Works Engineering Division recommends that a contract be awarded to low bidder Pape & Sons Construction, Inc., Gig Harbor, WA, for Local Improvement District (LID) 8654 and LID 8652-3. The contract amount reflects a base award of \$1,361,008, plus sales tax, plus a 10% contingency, for a cumulative amount of \$1,497,108.80, plus sales tax.

EXPLANATION: This contract will construct standard pavement for four alleys and construct one alley with pervious pavement with an infiltration gallery. The work also includes construction of sewers with associated structures. This LID project includes work on private properties per property owner agreements. Work on private properties may include driveway construction, removal of obstructions and vegetation, and removal and construction of fences. The project also includes improving wastewater sewer systems and ADA compatible alley approaches at sidewalk crossings. The total project cost estimate including design, project management, construction management, inspection, construction, LID administration and sales tax is \$2,200,000. The alleys are located at:

• The alley between North 37th Street and North 38th Street, from Mullen Street to Ferdinand Street, also North 38th Street from Mullen Street to Ferdinand Street;

LID 8654

- The alley between North 11th Street and North 12th Street from Adams Street to Proctor
- The alley between North 10th Street and North 11th Street from Cheyenne Street to Mullen Street;
- The alley between Shirley Street and Winnifred Street from North 14th Street to North 18th Street; and,
- The alley between North 29th Street and North 30th Street from Pine Street to Junett Street, also, Pine Street from North 29th Street northerly to alley.

COMPETITIVE BIDDING: Request for Bids Specification No. PW13-0603F was opened November 12, 2013. 10 submittals were received. The Small Business Enterprise (SBE) participation level proposed by the bidder(s) are reflected as a credit (maximum applies) against the submitted base bid to arrive at an "evaluated bid" for ranking purposes. Pape & Sons Construction, Inc. submitted a bid that resulted in the lowest evaluated submittal after consideration of SBE participation goals. The table below reflects the amount of the base award.

CONTRACT HISTORY: New contract.

<u>FUNDING</u>: Funds are budgeted in the Streets Special Revenue Fund 1060 per authorizing Ordinances 28067 and 28073, ES Surface Water 4301 Fund and ES Wastewater 4300 Fund. Funding beyond the current biennium is subject to future availability of funds.

<u>SUSTAINABILITY</u>: This project will install new asphalt pavement for four alleys reducing dust and providing storm water management and one alley with pervious asphalt with a storm water infiltration gallery. The project also includes improving sewer systems and ADA compatible alley approaches at sidewalk crossings. The project will include the Local Employment and Apprenticeship Training Program.

<u>SBE/LEAP COMPLIANCE</u>: The recommended contractor is in compliance with the Small Business Enterprise (SBE) Regulation requirements per memorandum dated November 22, 2013. The SBE goal for this project is 15 %. The SBE participation level of the recommended contractor is 15 %. Pape & Sons Construction, Inc. submitted the lowest evaluated bid per the SBE Regulation requirements. The Local Employment and Apprenticeship Training Program (LEAP) goal is 1,050 hours.
