## Proposed Amendment

- Clarify that “playgrounds” and “recreation centers or facilities” owned by Metro Parks Tacoma are also subject to buffering requirements for marijuana businesses

## Why the Proposed Amendment?

- Address the gap between the intent and definitions in State law
- Alleviate permitting problems
- Provide protective measures until State corrects the definitions
