**SUMMARY:**

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities: appointing Anthony Caldwell, Wandaya Terry and Lori Allison to serve three-year terms to expire August 31, 2019; appointing James Williams to fill an unexpired term to expire August 31, 2018; and reappointing Roxanne Miles to serve a three-year term to expire August 31, 2019.

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

Appointing individuals to the Committee best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to encouraging and promoting an open, effective, results-oriented organization by ensuring the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities has full membership and can continue to advise the City Council in policy making, partner with the community to bring awareness of issues that affect individuals with disabilities, participate on committees, educate the public about disability issues, and serve as a resource for City staff.

**ISSUE:**
