Council Member Ibsen moved to approve the minutes of the July 24, 2013 and August 14, 2013 meetings. Seconded by Council Member Walker. Voice vote was taken and carried. The minutes were approved.

Six Year Plan

At approximately 4:37 p.m. Jennifer Kammerzell, Public Works, reviewed the Six-Year Transportation Improvement Program, including an overview of today's presentation, background information, current issues, added and deleted projects, next steps, and staff recommendations. Ms. Kammerzell then provided an update on crosswalk implementation and the top four bike ways. Discussion ensued regarding added projects, potential funding impacts if Proposition 1 passes, when this item will come back to this Committee, parking, improvements on Mildred Street, and when Stadium Way will reopen. Deputy Mayor Campbell requested information regarding the impact of improvements at South 17th Street and Jefferson Avenue on the Greater Tacoma and Convention Center entrance and garage; Council Member Mello requested staff share this information with the full Council.

Carmen White, City Manager's Office, stated at the September 11, 2013 meeting there will be an update on the First Creek Action Plan and the 2015 Comprehensive Plan.

None.


