3. [22-0713](#) WorkForce Partnerships Update
[Katie Condit, Chief Executive Officer, WorkForce Central]

At approximately 10:09 a.m., Jeff Robinson, Director, Community and Economic Development (CED), provided opening remarks and introduced Katie Condit, Chief Executive Officer, WorkForce Central, who presented

the WorkForce Central partnerships update, including Pierce County businesses; Pierce County total wage distribution; average annual wages in Pierce County; top occupations by total demand; Pierce County labor supply and demand; and next steps.

Discussion ensued regarding how to use WorkForce Central to increase wages in non-profit sectors; changing the City's model around contract funding; how the City only has two of the occupations over 50 percent annual media income that are listed as high demand; the influence the City has on jobs and pay; and how much of the labor force that is trained is moving to King County.

At approximately 10:40 a.m., Shari Hart, Lead Business Program Specialist, CED, presented the window replacement program update, including an overview; background; grant process; applications; selections; fund and grant status; demographics, noting race or ethnicity, languages spoken, gender, and Council District; and community input.

Discussion ensued regarding community outreach; funding for windows that still need repairing versus windows that have already been repaired; data on broken windows; and funding for security enhancement.
