SUMMARY:

The Police Department is recommending renewal of a two year contract with the Tacoma Pierce County Humane Society to provide animal sheltering and related services for the City.

BACKGROUND:

In January 1, 2006, the City assumed responsibility for animal control services and entered into an agreement with the Humane Society for animal shelter and related services to be renewed for each following calendar year.

ISSUE:

Since 2006 the City and Humane Society have renewed this contract on an annual basis. This year it was agreed that a two year contract would be beneficial to the Humane Society and the City moving forward.

ALTERNATIVES:

This is an information briefing only. There are no alternatives presented.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impact in 2015 is \$438,520 and \$442,836 in 2016 with a total contract amount for years 2015/2016 of \$881,356. This item was included in the approved 2015/2016 budget.
