SUMMARY:

Appointing Sheryl Ellis to the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities to fill an unexpired term to expire August 31, 2017.

COUNCIL SPONSORS:

Council Members Woodards, Campbell and Lonergan.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

Appointing individuals to the Committee best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to encouraging and promoting an open, effective, results-oriented organization by ensuring the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities has full membership and can continue to advise the City Council in policy making, partner with the community to bring awareness of issues that affect individuals with disabilities, participate on committees, educate the public about disability issues, and serve as a resource for City staff.

BACKGROUND:

At the March 26, 2015 Public Safety, Human Services, and Education Committee meeting, the Committee recommended the appointment of Sheryl Ellis.

ISSUE:

Two positions need to be filled on the Tacoma Area Commission on Disabilities.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Commission would operate without full membership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Public Safety, Human Services, and Education Committee is recommending the appointment of the individual listed above.
