**SUMMARY:**

Appointing Paul Throne to the At-Large No. 2 position on the Tacoma Arts Commission to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2016.

**STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:**

Appointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic priority policy related to fostering neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability because the Commission provides leadership in supporting and enhancing the arts for the benefit of the City and its residents.

**BACKGROUND:**

At the March 31, 2015 Economic Development Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews for positions available on the Tacoma Arts Commission. At the April 14, 2015 Economic Development Committee meeting, the Committee recommended the appointment of the individual listed above.
