



RESOLUTION NO. 39845

1 A RESOLUTION relating to construction of stormwater infrastructure; authorizing
2 the execution of an Interlocal Agreement with the Metropolitan Park District
3 of Tacoma, in the amount of \$450,000, excluding sales tax, including a
4 10 percent contingency, budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, to plug
and abandon an existing stormwater pipe and construct a replacement
54-inch diameter pipe as part of the Point Defiance Trail Phase I project.

5 WHEREAS the Waterfront and Peninsula project area within Point Defiance
6 Park, also known as the Triangle Area, is designed to create a more accessible,
7 active, and thriving waterfront, and

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9 WHEREAS the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma ("Metro Parks") has
10 planned certain park improvements for the Triangle Area, including a larger
11 vehicle/trailer parking area; an elevated walkway linking Ruston Way to Point
12 Defiance; a new 11-acre park on the peninsula; and a stormwater facility, through
13 partnership with the City, designed to protect the Puget Sound, and

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15 WHEREAS the Point Defiance Trail Phase I project, located within the
16 Triangle Area, includes capping a superfund site with park improvements over an
17 existing 91-year-old City stormwater pipe that the City planned to replace with a
18 54-inch diameter pipe, and

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20 WHEREAS, given the proximity of these projects to one another, it is
21 preferred that both projects be combined into a single public works project in order
22 to achieve economy of scale, ensure overall project coordination and
23 management, reduce overall costs, minimize impacts to the public, and maximize
24 public benefit, and

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26 WHEREAS Metro Parks will manage and administer the project, including all
public notifications, design and engineering, permitting, bidding, and construction;



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and the City will reimburse Metro Parks for its equitable share of the stormwater improvements, as well as the incremental construction management time associated with City bid items, all as more particularly set forth in the Interlocal Agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk; Now, Therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement with the Metropolitan Park District of Tacoma, in the amount of \$450,000, excluding sales tax, including a 10 percent contingency, budgeted from the Surface Water Fund, to plug and abandon an existing stormwater pipe and construct a replacement 54-inch diameter pipe as part of the Point Defiance Trail Phase I project, said agreement to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
