SUMMARY:

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Human Services Commission: Jovan Dumas, Korbett Mosesly, Roseanne Sat, Patricia Sully and Sean Waite to serve three-year terms to expire April 30, 2018.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

As the Human Services Commission serves as a resource to the City Council and City staff for implementation of the City's Human Services Strategic Plan, appointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic policy priority related to strengthening and supporting public safety and human services.

BACKGROUND:

At the April 23, 2015 Public Safety, Human Services, and Education Committee meeting, the Committee interviewed applicants and recommended the appointment of five individuals to the Human Services Commission.

ISSUE:

There are currently five three-year terms open on the Human Services Commission consisting of five three-year terms.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Commission would operate without full membership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Public Safety, Human Services, and Education Committee is recommending the appointment of the five individuals listed above to the Human Services Commission.
