## OVERVIEW

- Cityoftacoma.org is our primary platform for informing & engaging with our community
- Critical for belief & trust
- Has been in existence since 2013
- We're in the process of redesigning it -- anticipated to launch in Spring 2025

## PROJECT GOALS

- Improve navigation & enhance findability
- Modernize the design
- Increase accessibility & usability
- Improve transparency & content accuracy
- Enhance resident engagement
- Improve information assurance/security

## BACKGROUND

- Website assessment conducted (late 2022-mid 2023)
- RFP process & selection-Tacoma-based, SiteCrafting selected as vendor (late 2023)
- Project Planning & Stakeholder Analysis (Spring 2024)
- Content Audit (Summer 2024)
- Usability Testing & Focus Groups (June 2024)
- **Community Engagement (June 2024)**

## RESEARCH

- The SiteCrafting collaborated with the City of Tacoma to create a working prototype of the new designs.
- SiteCrafting conducted usability testing, focus groups and community outreach.
- Usability testing and focus group scenarios focused on the usability of the new navigation and templates.
- Community outreach focused on engaging with community members and collecting information on their ideas for features for the new site.

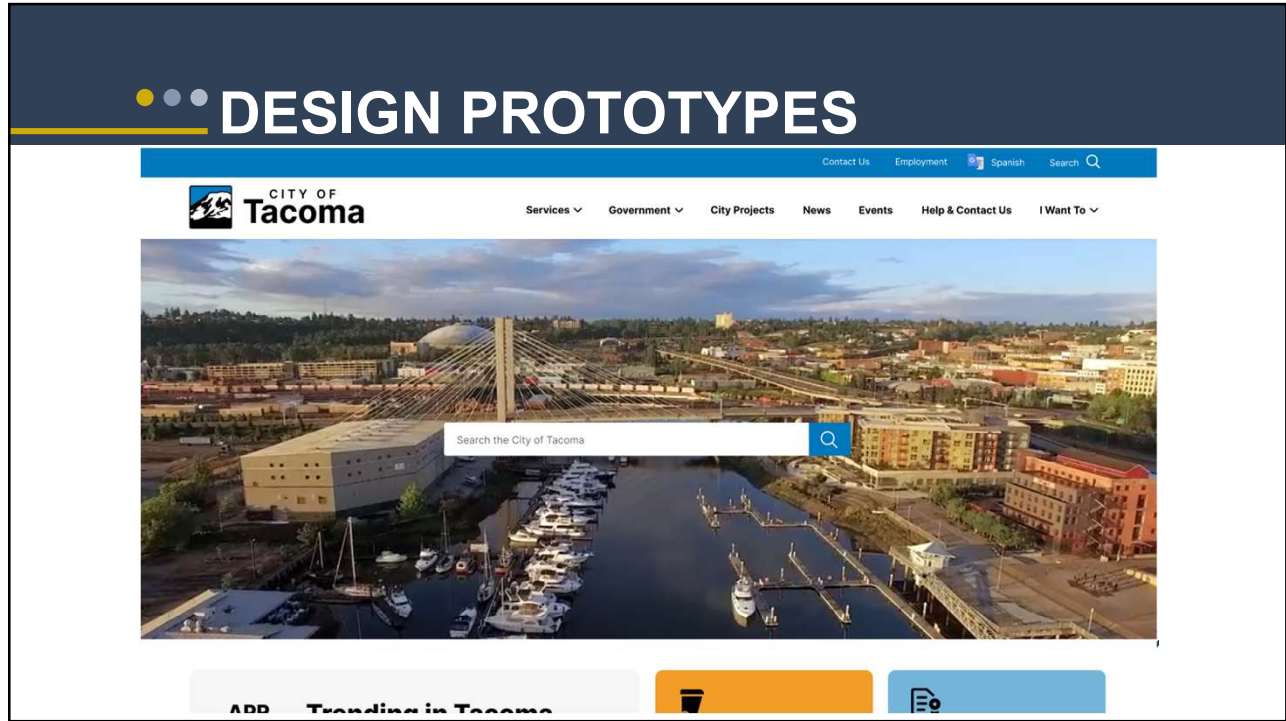

## METHODOLOGY

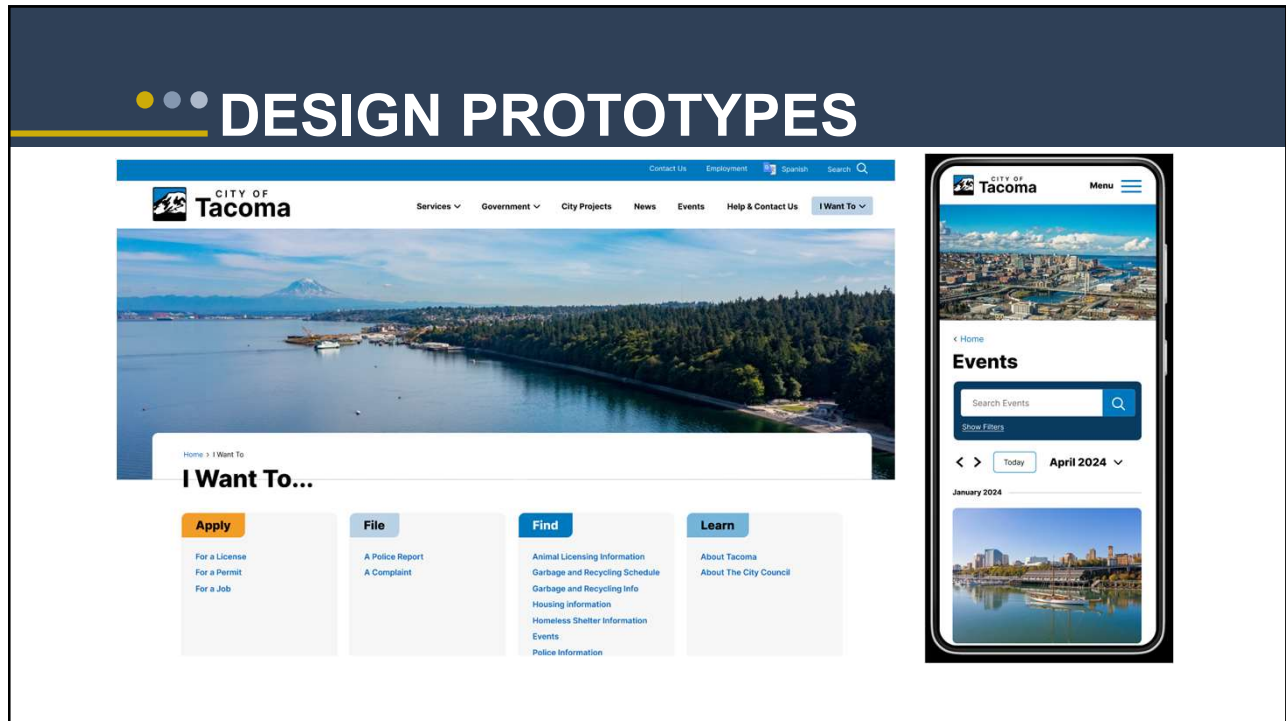
- **Usability Study**
  - 12 participants
  - In-person moderated
- **Focus Groups**
  - 2 sessions
  - 9 participants (community groups and business organizations)
  - In-person moderated
- **Community Engagement**
  - One Tacoma Community Visioning Workshop Events
    - Bates Technical College
    - Salishan Family Investment Center

## METHODOLOGY

### • Usability Studies & Focus Groups

- Conducted in-person at SiteCrafting
- Participants were asked to complete 11 tasks and scenarios within the newly designed environment
  - *How would you find City Council's goals and priorities?*
  - *How would you file a police report?*
  - *Where would you go to find information on affordable housing?*

## OVERALL FINDINGS

- Feedback on the new designs was overwhelmingly positive.
- Average task success rate was 82%
- Participants really liked the Resource hub pages, especially the "I Want To" sections.
- Overall satisfaction in Usability Testing was **6.45 (out of 7)**. Highest satisfaction score ever reported.



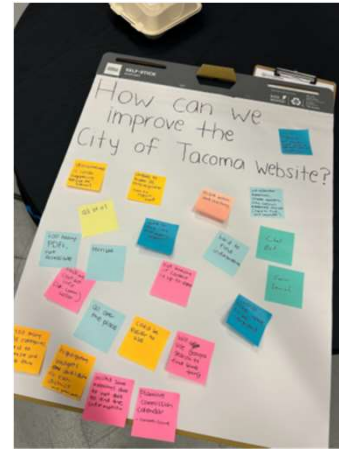

Attendees were asked to provide feedback on the site and what they would like to see on a new site.

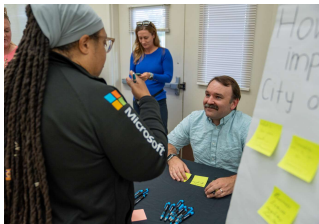
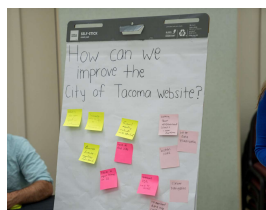
Responses included:

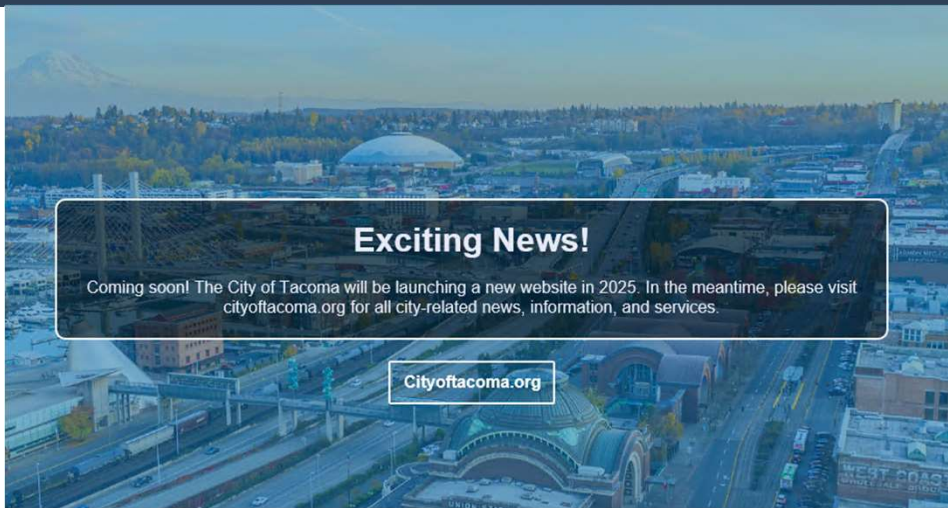
