**SUMMARY:**

This informational briefing will provide details on Metropolitan Development Council (MDC) efforts to support faith-based and non-profit organizations in identifying and establishing temporary shelter sites in Tacoma.

**BACKGROUND:**

City Council approved Purchase Resolution RES40460 on October 29, 2019, to fund a contract with Metropolitan Development Council for a convening of faith-based organizations, non-profit organizations, and community stakeholders for the purpose of identifying and establishing temporary shelter sites in Tacoma.

**ISSUE:**

MDC is collaborating with Associated Ministries and The Ministerial Alliance to convene community meetings and conduct a landscape analysis and asset mapping to determine the feasibility and options for temporary shelter site locations in Tacoma. A report on the community convenings and an update of the landscape analysis will be presented.
