Briefing Items

1. 14-0704 Public Access, Service & Security Initiative and TacomaFIRST 311 Mobile Application

Mayor Strickland announced the first study session topic is the Public Access, Service and Security (P.A.S.S.) Initiative and TacomaFIRST 311 mobile application.

Council Member Ibsen arrived here, at 12:11 p.m.

Nadia Chandler Hardy, Assistant to the City Manager, provided opening remarks and reviewed the agenda for today's presentation. Justin Davis, Facilities Division Manager, reviewed space planning and security efforts. Discussion ensued regarding outreach efforts related to building hours. Council Member Lonergan requested staff provide information regarding the new building hours to individuals with meetings that begin before the building opens.

La'Toya Mason, Customer Support Center (CSC) Manager, reviewed TacomaFIRST 311, including CSC statistics, the top ten online service requests, and the 311 mobile application. Discussion ensued regarding calls received from individuals outside the City's jurisdiction, the 311 mobile application, the response when there is a trend in complaints received, and the layout of the 311 mobile application. Mayor Strickland requested staff include the option to pay fines in the 311 mobile application.

Jack Kelanic, Information Technology Director, reviewed the open data pilot called TacomaData, including the definition of open data, best practices, program alignment, and the vision and approach. He then provided a demonstration of the system. Mayor Strickland requested additional information regarding the level of detail provided in search results, such as listing the types of homicides when searching for homicide data. Ms. Hardy concluded by reviewing next steps.
