SUMMARY:

Appointing the following individuals to the Landmarks Preservation Commission:

- Appointing Jennifer Sullivan to the “At-Large No. 2” position to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2024.
- Appointing George Zeno to the “At-Large No. 3” position to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2024.

COUNCIL SPONSORS:

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

As the Commission oversees the establishment and regulation of landmarks, local historic districts, proposed name changes for public facilities, and certain property tax incentives, appointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic policy priority to foster neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability.

BACKGROUND:

At the February 10, 2021 Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews and recommended Jennifer Sullivan to a short list for appointment to the next available position. A vacancy has occurred, therefore Jennifer Sullivan is being recommended to fill that position. At the February 9, 2022 Committee meeting, the Committee conducted interviews and recommended George Zeno for appointment.

ISSUE:

Positions need to be filled on the Landmarks Preservation Commission.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Commission will continue to operate without full membership.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Infrastructure, Planning, and Sustainability Committee is recommending the appointment of the individuals listed above.
