SUMMARY AND PURPOSE:

A resolution Nominating and Electing Council Member Joe Bushnell as the Deputy Mayor of the City of Tacoma through December 31, 2026.

BACKGROUND:

Council Member Kiara Daniels' term as Deputy Mayor will expire December 31, 2025. Council Members who indicate interest in serving qualifies them as a candidate for Deputy Mayor.

Per Ordinance No. 26767, the Deputy Mayor shall be a member of the City Council and shall be elected by the Council at its first meeting after such office becomes vacant, or as soon thereafter as practical. The term of such office shall be for one year.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT/ CUSTOMER RESEARCH:

Any Council Member can indicate interest at the first meeting of year to be considered for the Deputy Mayor role.

Electing a Deputy Mayor to act as the presiding officer in the Mayor's absence encourages and promotes an open, effective, results-oriented organization that is responsive to the needs of our community.
