



RESOLUTION NO. 41876

1 A RESOLUTION setting Tuesday, April 21, 2026, upon completion of Regular
2 Agenda Items, no earlier than 5:15 p.m., as the date for a public hearing
3 by the City Council on the Draft Tacoma-Lakewood HOME Consortium
4 2026 Annual Action Plan for housing, community and economic
5 development, and public services.

6 WHEREAS the City is obligated to submit an Annual Action Plan (“AAP”)
7 to receive entitlement funding from the Unites States Department of Housing and
8 Urban Development (“HUD”), and

9 WHEREAS the AAP outlines the uses of Community Development Fund
10 Grant (“CDBG”), HOME Investment Partnerships (“HOME”), and Emergency
11 Solutions Grant (“ESG”) funds, and the AAP also includes the distribution of
12 funds to the City’s HOME Consortium partner, the City of Lakewood, and

13 WHEREAS the City has drafted a spending plan for the following estimated
14 grant amounts to be received from HUD for program year 2026: CDBG funds in the
15 amount of \$2,370,358, ESG funds in the amount of \$207,272, and HOME funds in
16 the amount of \$1,070,526, and

17 WHEREAS funding recommendations for the allocations stated above are
18 incorporated into the AAP, and the AAP is required by HUD in order for the City
19 to receive its entitlement funding, and

20 WHEREAS on May 5, 2026, staff will present the AAP to the City Council
21 and seek final action on its submittal to HUD, and prior to seeking final action
22 from the City Council on submitting the AAP to HUD, the City is required to
23 provide the opportunity for public comment, and
