Briefing Items

1. <u>15-0819</u> Marijuana Regulations

At approximately 12:08 p.m., Elizabeth Pauli, City Attorney, provided an update on marijuana enforcement, including recent regulatory history.

Council Member Thoms arrived here, at 12:10 p.m.

Ms. Pauli continued her update by reviewing December 2014 and April 2015 discussions surrounding enforcement, legislation, issues to discuss, and recommendations. Brian Boudet, Planning and Development Services, provided a dispersion map, and discussed next steps, including recommendations and Municipal Code changes planned for early 2016. Discussion ensued regarding union workers, timeline, future endorsements, access, regulation of hours, medical enhancements, retail outlets, store closures before July 2016, state preference tiers and criteria, focusing on problematic collectives, legislation, appeals, and allocations.

2. <u>15-0829</u> Billboard Regulations

At approximately 1:10 p.m., Mr. Boudet presented an overview of billboard regulations, including issues and recommendations, basic parameters of the Exchange Program and Companion Agreement, and provided a tentative schedule. Discussion ensued regarding pedestrian scale signage, removing design requirements, and signs on roofs.

Other Items of Interest

Deputy Mayor Boe stated he would be proposing two amendments to Resolution No. 39255, related to the alignment of the Sound Transit Link expansion. He stated his amendments would be relative to station locations and the use of center platforms. Discussion ensued regarding the amendments.

Committee Reports

Council Member Lonergan stated that last week South Sound 911 held its annual joint operations and policy board meeting and that the predominant topic discussed was radio system access.
