

RESOLUTION NO. 40731

A RESOLUTION relating to collective bargaining; authorizing the execution of a Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Professional Public Safety Management Association, regarding Voluntary Employee Beneficiary Association eligibility requirements.

WHEREAS the City has, for years, adopted the policy of collective bargaining between the various labor organizations representing employees and the administration, and

WHEREAS Resolution No. 40185, adopted December 11, 2018, authorized the execution of the two-year Collective Bargaining Agreement ("CBA") between the City of Tacoma and Professional Public Safety Management Association ("Union"), on behalf of the employees represented by said Union, and

WHEREAS the City and Union have negotiated a Letter of Agreement ("LOA") to the CBA which provides an exception to the age and years of service eligibility requirement of the Voluntary Employee Beneficiary Association ("VEBA") program for Assistant Police Chief Michael Ake for the calendar year 2021 only, and

WHEREAS it appears in the best interest of the City that the LOA negotiated by said Union and the City be approved; Now, Therefore,



BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:

That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Letter of Agreement negotiated between the City of Tacoma and the Professional Public Safety Management Association, said document to be substantially in the form of the document on file in the office of the City Clerk.
