SUMMARY:

Appointing and reappointing the following individuals to the Landmarks Preservation Commission: Appointing Kevin Bartoy to the At-Large No. 1 position to fill an unexpired term to expire December 31, 2017, and Kenneth House to the Professional No. 1 position to serve a three-year term to expire December 31, 2019; and reappointing Jeff Williams to the Professional No. 2 position, and Jonah Jensen to the Architect No. 2 position to serve three-year terms to expire December 31, 2019.

STRATEGIC POLICY PRIORITY:

As the Commission oversees the establishment and regulation of landmarks, local historic districts, proposed name changes for public facilities, and certain property tax incentives, appointing and reappointing individuals to the Commission best aligns with the strategic policy priority to foster neighborhood, community, and economic development vitality and sustainability.
