## **RESOLUTION NO. 41689**

A RESOLUTION authorizing the acceptance of a grant from the Washington 1 State Department of Transportation, in the amount of \$982,000, and 2 depositing said sum into the Special Revenue Fund; for the purchase of an electric boat and authorizing a subrecipient agreement with 3 Communities for a Healthy Bay. 4 WHEREAS the 2023-2025 Washington State Supplemental 5 Transportation Budget includes a proviso allocating \$982,000 to provide 6 7 Communities for a Healthy Bay ("CHB") with an electric boat through the Move 8 Ahead Washington ("MAWA") Capital Projects program, and 9 WHEREAS, on January 3, 2025, the City of Tacoma received a letter 10 from Washington State Department of Transportation ("WSDOT") notifying the 11 City that they would serve as a pass-through entity for the project, and 12 WHEREAS to facilitate the distribution of these funds, the City must 13 14 enter into an agreement with CHB, and formally accept the award from 15 WSDOT, and 16 WHEREAS this agreement does not allocate or otherwise commit any 17 City funds towards CHB's purchase, rather, the agreement commits the City to 18 19 serve as a conduit between WSDOT and CHB for reimbursement, and 20 WHEREAS the agreement requires CHB to select a vendor to purchase 21 an electric boat for an amount not to exceed \$982,000, and 22 WHEREAS upon payment to the vendor, CHB will provide the City with 23 invoice(s), proof of payment(s), and additional documentation as requested, 24 25 and 26 -1-



	WHEREAS the agreement requires the City to submit documentation to
1	WSDOT, receive funds, and distribute funds to CHB as received, and
2	WHEREAS, under the grant process guidelines, the City Council must
3 4	approve acceptance of grant funding; Now, Therefore,
4 5	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TACOMA:
6	Section 1. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to
7	accept a grant award from Washington State Department of Transportation in
8	the amount of \$982,000, for deposit into the Special Revenue Fund.
9	Section 2. That the proper officers of the City are hereby authorized to
10 11	execute an agreement with Communities for a Healthy Bay to facilitate the
12	reimbursement of the funds accepted pursuant to Section 1, said document to
13	be substantially in the form of the proposed grant agreement on file in the office
14	of the City Clerk.
